INTRODUCTION: Normal civic life and public order have been seriously affected due to terrorist activities in the State of Jammu & Kashmir. Quite a large number of people in the State have been displaced and have sought shelter with their relatives in other parts of the country or in the rehabilitation camps. The social and economic life of these people has been considerably disrupted with the result that their children have been considerably handicapped in preparing their studies. Similarly, quite a large number of officers and such of the military and para-military forces have been deployed in the State to combat terrorists' activities. These officers and staff have to discharge onerous duties against heavy odds. Children of such officers and staff and also all officers belonging to Indian Administration Service and Indian Police Service posted in Jammu and Kashmir have been facing difficulties in continuing their education. Fortunately, adequate facilities are available in Maharashtra in the field of Agriculture, Horticulture, etc. The question of extending assistance to the above categories of students was under the consideration of Government for sometime.

RESOLUTION:


2. Government is now pleased to direct that the facilities for Higher Education in the field of Agriculture and Horticulture at degree level will be provided to children of citizens displaced due to terrorists' activities. From Jammu & Kashmir as also children of officers belonging to Indian Administrative Service, Indian Police service and other officers and staff

belonging to military and para-military forces transferred to Jammu & Kashmir to deal with terrorists' activities.

In order to be eligible for admission to these courses, the students ought to fulfil the prescribed minimum educational qualifications laid down by the Maharashtra Council of Agriculture, Education & Research, Pune and/or Universities. So far as the admission to Degree Courses in Agriculture and Horticulture the candidates should have passed XIIth Standard examination in Physics, Chemistry, Biology and English. The candidates who have ~~not~~ Passed XIIth Standard with Botany and Zoology are also eligible.

In order to accommodate the eligible students for admission to the faculty of Agriculture and Horticulture, one ~~seat~~^{seat} per collage over and above the sanctioned intake capacity is hereby permitted to be created in every university and Aided Degree level institutions/collages. These seats cannot be allotted to any students other than those mentioned above. The applications for admission should be addressed on plain paper to Member-Secretary, Maharashtra Council of Agriculture, Education and Research College of Agriculture Compound, Pune-411005 and submitted by post on or before 20th September, 1995 at the latest. The list of Agriculture and Horticulture Collages in the State of Maharashtra is given in Annexure 'B'. Applications received thereafter will not be entertained. The requisite documents accompanying the applications for admission have been indicated in Annexure-A. Applicant may indicate the choice of collage/courses and the allotment shall be strictly on merit basis. Personal inquiries will not be entertained and allotment once made shall be final. The Maharashtra Council of Agriculture, Education and Research should give an advertisement in this regard in English in the National level news papers.

- 1) Certificate of marks obtained in the qualifying examination.
- 2) School/Institution Leaving (after qualifying examination) certificate.
- 3) Certificate of marks obtained at S.S.C. or its equivalent examination.
- 4) For Government servants or person serving in Military or para-Military Service certificate from the Head of Department/University where they are serving
- 5) Those staying in migrant/refuges camps and those who are registered with Govt. as migrant should submit certificates from the office of the Migrant/Refugee Camp.
- 6) Displaced persons staying with relatives/friends anywhere in the country other than in refuges camps should enclose a certificate from the District Magistrate of the district where they are staying to the effect that the parents/guardians of the candidate is a displaced person from M Jammu & Kashmir due to recent disturbances (1990 onwards)

The candidates are advised if any of the certificates mentioned above is not in English or Hindi, a copy of English translation duly signed by Head Master/Principal of recognised institute, should be enclosed.
